



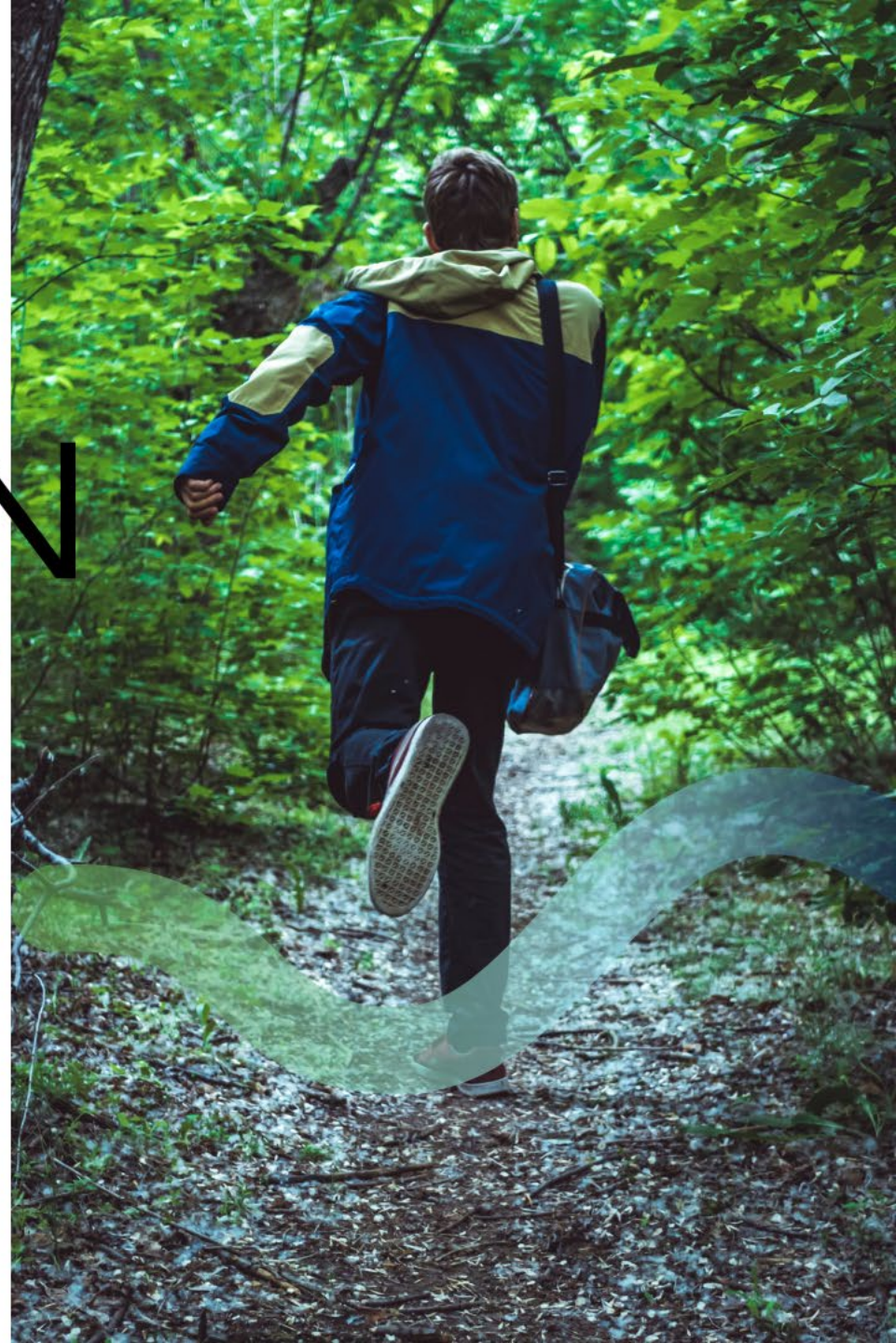

HEBREWS 3

Therefore, holy brothers and sisters, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession: Jesus;² He was faithful to Him who appointed Him, as Moses also was in all His house.

⁴ treacherous, reckless, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ holding to a form of godliness although they have denied its power; avoid such people as these. ⁶ For among them are those who slip into households and captivate weak women weighed down with sins, led on by various impulses,

2 TIMOTHY 3:1-9

⁷ always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth. ⁸ Just as Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these men also oppose the truth, men of depraved mind, worthless in regard to the faith.

2 TIMOTHY 3:1-9

⁹ But they will not make further progress; for their foolishness will be obvious to all, just as was that also of Jannes and Jambres.
