For God So Loved the World

God's love is what He uses to save people from eternal punishment.

John 3:16-17 KJV For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. [17] For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.

These verses reveal the plan that God had to set people free from satan's captivity. Satan uses sin to imprison people; God uses love to set them free.

Romans 8:31-32 KJV What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

I've been a minister of God for over 40 years, and if I've seen it once, I've seen it a thousand times; people are still trying to pay God for their salvation. What Jesus did on that cross was the FINAL sacrifice for mankind's sin. It is OVER! Mankind can now be free forever of their sin through Jesus' final sacrifice for them.

Hebrews 9:27-28 KJV And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: [28] So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

So all of us that are born again are free from all sins. There is only one sin that sends people to hell, that is the sin of rejecting Jesus.

Romans 5:6-9 KJV For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. [7] For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. [8] But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.

Jesus died for all of man's sins. Not one sin that is being committed or has been committed or will be committed was not put on Jesus on the cross. If we believe and receive Him; we will be born again and we will live with Him forever.
