Jesus Was Dead; Now He Is Alive Forevermore!

Revelation 1:18 KJV I am He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

“Jesus was a good man”; this is what a lot of religions preach. They don’t deny that Jesus was a man sent from God to do good works for mankind, but they stop at Him being raised from the dead and that He is alive forevermore. They really don’t understand the mission for which Jesus came to the earth. Jesus came to die for the sins of humanity. God His Father sent Him to be our substitutionary sacrifice for all of our sins. The death of Jesus guaranteed that all of man’s sins were put on Him and He died with them. To anyone that believes that Jesus was resurrected from the dead, He will give them salvation from eternal hell. Let’s look at Scriptures in the Bible that point this out.

Romans 10:9-10 KJV That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. [10] For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 4:24-25 KJV But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on Him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; [25] Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

Nobody can save themselves with their good works. Most of the so-called Christian religions today preach a perverted gospel. On one hand they believe that Jesus died for their sins, but on the other hand they believe that they must do everything right according to the law of Moses in order to not go to hell. This false gospel teaches people that their good works will save them; not that only Jesus’ death on the cross can save anyone. Let’s look at some Scriptures that bear this out.

Romans 5:6-10 KJV For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. [7] For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. [8] But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. [10] For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

Always remember that if Jesus didn't die for our sins, there is no way that we will go to Heaven. God will never let sin into Heaven. When we accept what Jesus did for us through His death for our sins, we are accepting that our sins are paid for forever. The only sin that will send a person to hell is their not accepting Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

As we close this Newsletter today, read and think about the following Scriptures; and let your Father God fill you with joy in believing.

Revelation 2:8 KJV And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the First and the Last, which was dead, and is alive;

Revelation 1:5 KJV And from Jesus Christ, Who is the Faithful Witness, and the First Begotten of the dead, and the Prince of the kings of the earth. Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood,

1 Thessalonians 4:15-18 KJV For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. [16] For the Lord Himself shall descend from Heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: [17] Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. [18] Wherefore comfort one another with these words.
