Mercy Rejoices Against Judgment

James 2:12-13 KJV So speak ye, and so do, as they that shall be judged by the law of liberty. [13] For he shall have judgment without mercy, that hath shewed no mercy; and mercy rejoiceth against judgment.

We are living in the end times; the Lord Jesus is coming very soon! I believe that we will see many people come to Jesus in these days. I believe that they will come, because God our Father is giving us revelation concerning His mercy and judgment.

I grew up in a time where God's grace and mercy were taught but were mixed with His judgment. I didn't hear much about the mercy, but I heard a lot about the judgment. I felt like I could never live a life that would allow me to go to Heaven. I thought that I had to work for my salvation, and at the same time I believed Jesus died for my sins. I believed I could get saved, but there was no guarantee I would stay saved. The reason for this was because I believed I had to do enough good works to stay saved. I didn't understand that my salvation was only determined by my faith in what Jesus had done on that cross; not by my works. In this Newsletter I will be showing you that we must give the world the revelation of salvation through mercy and grace, and that we can't work for salvation. Let's look at Scriptures today that bear this out.

Ephesians 2:8-9 KJV For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: [9] Not of works, lest any man should boast.

Notice Paul said not of works; so nobody is saved because they have enough good works.

1 Corinthians 15:21-22 KJV For since by man came death, by Man came also the resurrection of the dead. [22] For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

Romans 5:1-2, 17-19 KJV Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: [2] By Whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. [17] For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by One, Jesus Christ.) [18] Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. [19] For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of One shall many be made righteous.

Notice in these verses that we didn't make ourselves sinners. The first man Adam sinned, and we became sinners with his sin. Jesus is the last Adam. When we believe and accept Him as our Savior and Lord, we are born again; our spirit is made righteous, and we are no longer sinners. We are now the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus.

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV For He hath made Him to be sin for us, Who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

Today God wants you to think about your eternal security in Jesus. If you always believe in Jesus, you will never go to a devil's hell.
