Christians Have Two Birthdays

Christians have a physical birthday and, also, a spiritual one. We live our physical life through our natural bodies, and we live our spiritual lives through our spirits.

1 Peter 1:23 KJV Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the Word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.

John 3:3-8 KJV Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the Kingdom of God. [4] Nicodemus saith unto Him, How can a man be born when he is old? can he enter the second time into his mother's womb, and be born? [5] Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God. [6] That which is born

of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. [7] Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again. [8] The wind bloweth where it listeth, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit.

We see the Bible shows us our spiritual birth in these Scriptures. God wants us to learn how to live from our spirits; not just from our bodies.

In this Newsletter I will be giving you Scriptures so that we can live like Jesus on this earth through our new birth in Christ.

1 Thessalonians 5:23 KJV And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We are three parts; we are each a spirit, we have a soul (mind, will, and emotions) and we live

in a human body. The bornagain spirit is the real us. Your spirit is completely sinless, because it was born from the seed of the Word of God; and there is no sin in the Word of God. God wants us to start living from our sinless spirit, and we will no longer live a life of sin.

2 Corinthians 4:16 KJV For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed

day by day.

Now God has put brand new spirits in our bodies that are natural. We have the same bodies after we are born again that we had before our new birth. We now can live a whole new life in Christ, if we start learning how to live from our spirits.

2 Corinthians 5:16-18 KJV Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ

after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we Him no more. [17] Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. [18] And all things are of God, Who hath reconciled us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

God has a job for us to complete in the earth, so we must learn about, and start to

live from, our

new spirits; not just from our bodies. I will close with Scriptures that talk about our reborn spirits. Take them as your new identity in Christ.

1 Corinthians 14:14-15 KJV For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful. [15] What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will

sing with the understanding also.

Romans 8:15-17 KJV For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father. [16] The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God: [17] And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ; if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

1 John 5:1 KJV Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth Him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of Him.
