Free From the Fear of Death & Judgement

So many people live in fear today, and the main fear is the fear of death. Your body and my body was born in sin, and the wages of sin is death. Jesus came to this earth to pay the price for man's sin. When a Christian receives the revelation that their sins have been paid for, the fear that has gripped them will be driven away from their thinking; and freedom will be theirs! Let us look at Scriptures that bear this out.

1 John 4:9-10 KJV In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. [10] Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

1 John 4:16-18 KJV And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. [17] Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world. [18] There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.

These verses show that if we receive Jesus as our Lord and Savior, our sins are taken care of by Him. Then we don't have to be afraid when Judgment comes, because Jesus has already been punished or judged with our sins.

The Bible tells us that Jesus is the final sacrifice for sin. We cannot pay for our sins to appease God. Jesus satisfied justice by dying for all of mankind's sins. If anyone will come to Jesus and repent of their sins, God the Father will welcome them into the family of God and give them a new spirit; so they can live the Christian Life.

Hebrews 9:24-28 KJV For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into Heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: [25] Nor yet that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest entereth into the holy place every year with blood of others; [26] For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world hath He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. [27] And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: [28] So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for Him shall He appear the second time without sin unto salvation.

Hebrews 10:12-22 KJV But this man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; [13] From henceforth expecting till His enemies be made His footstool. [14] For by one offering He hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. [15] Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that He had said before, [16] This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; [17] And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. [18] Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. [19] Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, [20] By a new and living way, which He hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh; [21] And having an High Priest over the house of God; [22] Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.

In all of these scriptures we see over and over again how Jesus sacrificed His life for the sins of all mankind, and anyone that receives His sacrifice for their sins will be free from God's judgment. The wrath of God will not come on the believers that take their freedom in Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:9-10 KJV For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, [10] Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him.

Don't be afraid of your Father God. If you do wrong and sin and miss the mark, remember Jesus already died for that sin. Come boldly to the throne of grace and receive mercy.

Hebrews 4:15-16 KJV For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. [16] Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.
