What Are We Saying That God Can Agree With?

We are living in a world with a lot of words being spoken. People like to talk, but what are they saying? Do we say things in our daily conversations that are agreeable with God's pre-determined plans for our lives? God knows the end from the beginning, and He has already declared our lives before we were ever born. We must find in the Bible the words that God has spoken about us as believers, and then use our faith to watch them come to pass. This way the devil can't win against you. God never planned for the devil's work to be manifested in your life. The devil comes into a person's life when they are not believing God's pre-ordained plans for their lives. That happens because people just haven't read and studied the Bible and found their lives in Scripture.

This is how you can find your life: in the Bible. At first, you won't find the Scriptures speaking directly to you, but God is speaking to all of us indirectly. If God says that signs shall follow a believer, you must say, "I'm a believer, so signs follow me. Over and over in the Bible you will find yourself by declaring what God says to a group. Also God will speak to individuals, and it applies

to us. We must claim those verses as being God speaking to us. Now God gave us the Confession Booklet to find out what God says about us. We must read it and speak it out loud over our selves, then we will start experiencing God's pre-determined plan that He planned for us to live before we were ever born. In the rest of this Newsletter, I will be giving you Scripture that declares God's will for you. But you must believe them, confess them, and claim them for yourself as you read them.

Ephesians 1:3-7 KJV Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: [4] According as He hath chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love: [5] Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, [6] To the praise of the glory of His grace, wherein He hath made us accepted in the beloved. [7] In Whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace;

Romans 5:1-2, 6-10, 17 KJV Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: [2] By Whom also we have access by

faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

[6] For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly. [7] For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. [8] But God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. [9] Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. [10] For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

[17] For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by One, Jesus Christ.)

Romans 8:28-33 KJV And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose. [29] For Whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the Firstborn among many brethren. [30] Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also justified: and whom He justified, them He also glorified. [31] What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be

against us? [32] He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? [33] Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.

In all these Scriptures God is trying to get us to understand that He had plans for us before we were ever born. Christianity should be finding out what God's plans are for us and receiving them by faith; letting God's Holy Spirit inside of us bring all these Scripture verses into reality in our lives.
