## How to Never Go to Hell

The Bible tells us plainly how to avoid going to hell. First, you must know what sends a person to hell; then you can understand how to not go. Sin has never sent a person to hell! There is only one thing that sends people to hell, and that is to not receive Jesus as their Lord and Savior. According to Romans 3:23 KJV For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God.

Mankind has sinned because they were born with the sin nature that was transferred to them through the first man, Adam.

Romans 5:18,19 KJV Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. [19]For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of One shall many be made righteous.

When Jesus came to this earth, He came on a mission to be the sin substitute. He didn't just come to heal a few people and make a great name for Himself, He came to allow His Father God to put the sins of all of humanity on Him. Now anyone that receives Jesus will never have to go to hell, because their sins have been put on Jesus; and He was punished on the cross for us.

2 Corinthians 5:21 KJV For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.

5:21 MSG How? you ask. In Christ. God put the wrong on Him who never did anything wrong, so we could be put right with God.

5:21 NCV Christ had no sin, but God made Him become sin so that in Christ we could become right with God.

5:21 NLT For God made Christ, Who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

5:21 TPT For God made the only One who did not know sin to become sin for us, so that we who did not know righteousness might become the righteousness of God through our union with Him.

In all these translations, we see God's sacrifice system in operation. In the Old Testament, God would allow animals to be sacrificed for the sins of the people. In the New Testament, God received Jesus' sacrifice as the final sacrifice for our sins. If we receive Jesus, Who died for our sins, as our substitute, we will never be punished in hell. Heaven is then where we will go after our physical life is over on the earth.

Hebrews 10:8-10 TPT First He said, "Multiple burnt-offerings and sin-offerings cannot satisfy Your justice" (even though the law required them to be offered). [9] And then He said, "God, I will be the One to go and do Your will." So by being the sacrifice that removes sin, He abolishes animal sacrifices and replaces that entire system with the new covenant. [10] By God's will we have been purified and made holy once and for all through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus, the Messiah!

I hope that you will study this Newsletter till you have complete confidence that you will never go to hell because of your sins. Father God has already punished Jesus with your sins, so you can now have confidence that you're right with God.
