The Christian Center Pastor Paul's Newsletter 10-12-25 Living in God's Safe House

God wants you to know that He has a place for you to live that will keep you protected. This Newsletter will reveal to you how to get there and how to stay in that safe place; but we must first find this place in the Bible.

To begin our search, let's think about this scenario; the FBI has a witness that can put away a bad guy. The bad guy has friends that want to kill the witness, so where does the FBI take the witness? You got it; to a safe house. We are in this evil world, and the devil wants to kill us; but God has a safe house for us to live in. Now, let's get into the Scriptures so we can find out where this place is. Here we go...

God and His words are synonymous. Now I know that if I'm with my God, nothing can harm me; because God has more power than anyone or anything. So if God and His words are the same, I can get into God's Word (the Bible), and I'll be close to God; and by this I'm in His safe house.

John 15:7 KJV If ye abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

The words of Jesus are true, and God can't lie; so this Scripture verse is true. If the words of Jesus are living in me, then I'm living in God's safe house.

So let's look at other Scriptures that talk about our protection.

Matthew 7:24-25 KJV Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of Mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: [25] And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

Mark 11:22-24, 16:15-29 KJV And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. [23] For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. [24] Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

Mark 16:15-20 And He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. [16] He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. [17] And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; [18] They shall take up serpents;

and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. [19] So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, He was received up into Heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. [20] And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Isaiah 54:17 KJV No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of Me, saith the LORD.

1 John 4:15-19 KJV Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God. [16] And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him. [17] Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world. [18] There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. [19] We love Him, because He first loved us.

Luke 10:19 KJV Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Psalm 91:1-7 KJV He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. [2] I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in Him will I trust. [3] Surely He shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. [4] He shall cover thee with His feathers, and under His wings shalt thou trust: His truth shall be thy shield and buckler. [5] Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; [6] Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. [7] A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee.

Now if these Scriptures live in our heart, and we speak them in faith, we will live in God's safe house.
