WHY?

The big question that man has is, "Why do bad things happen in the earth?" Our Father God wrote the Bible that contains the explanation to this question; so in this Newsletter, we will be showing you the answer.

Bad things that are happening in the earth are a direct result of Adam giving satan the authority to rule. Adam sinned when he ate the fruit, and thereby made satan the lord over mankind. But remember that Jesus came and was born a man. He never sinned, so satan could not rule Him; in fact, Jesus started ruling the devil.

When Jesus died for our sins, He stopped satan from having authority over us. The only power the devil has over us now is through our lack of understanding that Jesus' blood blotted out all of our sins. The devil cannot rule a believer in Jesus, if they understand the devil's lordship comes through man's sin and that Jesus' blood did away with our sins. Let me show you these facts through Scriptures in the Bible.

Genesis 1:26-28 KJV And God said, Let Us make man in Our image, after Our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. [27] So God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them. [28] And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.

This was a perfect world, and mankind was in charge. They were so blessed, but they ruined it all by disobeying God.

Genesis 2:16-17 KJV And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat: [17] But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die. 3:4-6 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: [5] For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. [6] And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

Romans 5:17-19 KJV For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by One, Jesus Christ.) [18] Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of One the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. [19] For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of One shall many be made righteous.

We are getting closer and closer to the end. We must go out in Jesus' Name and destroy the works of the devil. How do we do that? We must understand that there is a new sheriff in town, and that sheriff is Jesus' church.

1 John 3:8-9 KJV He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil. [9] Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

In these verses we see Jesus destroyed the works of the devil and the works of the devil is mentioned as sin. When a person becomes born again, they receive a new spirit; and that new spirit does not sin, because it is born of Jesus' seed. Now our flesh can sin, but not our reborn spirit. If we live out of our new spirit, the devil is powerless against us.
