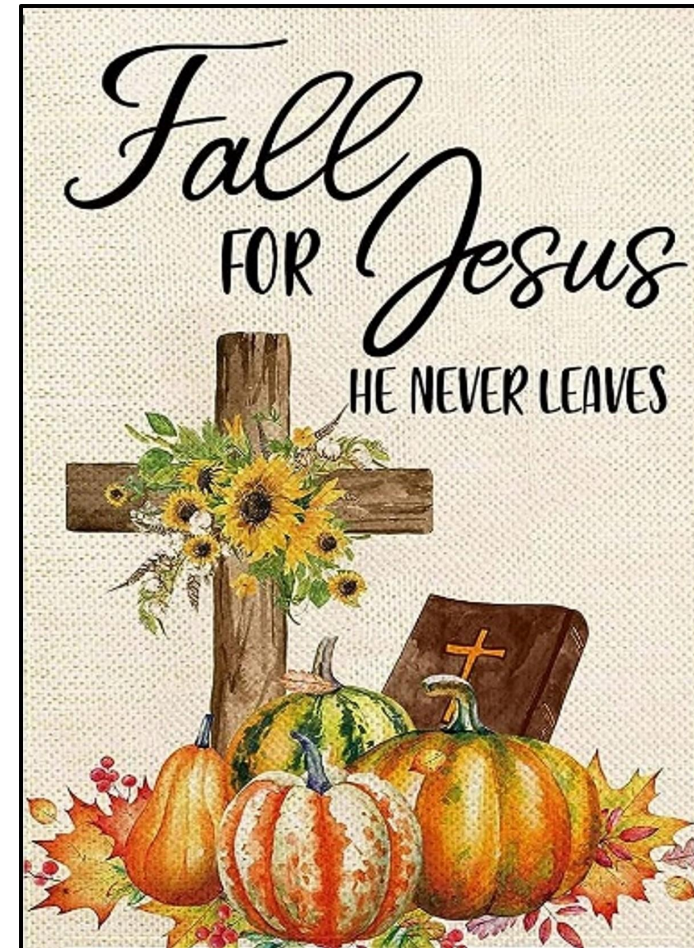

## MATTHEW 21:28-32 (Rev. Richard Rossow)
