***Selah after vs 4,7, 15 transition of intensity

- A. Hebrew word for shout vs 1 is “rua” vigorous worship in the context of a battle cry, victory cry or joyful exclamations.
- B. Hebrew word for God is “Elohim” is God who is the sum of all that is godly
- C. Hebrew word for earth is “Eres” and included believers and unbelievers
- D. Hebrew word glory is “Kabod” an aura of God’s appearance in His Majesty, authority
- E. Make his praise glorious- an offer of glory in humility
- F. Hebrew word for praise is “Hallel” if you add “yah” for Yahweh Praise the LORD
- G. Hebrew word for awesome is “yare” which means fearsome with respect and reverence
- H. Hebrew word for submit is “Kahas” which means cringe.
- I. Hebrew word for worship is “Shachah” which means bow down
