TWO TOOLS THE "CHURCH FAMILY" NEEDS

- 1. CONFESSION
- 2. RECLAMATION

WHY ARE THESE TOOLS NECESSARY?

In **confession**, you go to somebody and say, "<u>I'VE SINNED</u>. I'm caught in its snare. <u>HELP</u> me. I need help."

But in **reclamation**, you have to go to somebody and say, "<u>YOU'RE</u> caught in <u>SIN'S</u> snare. You need help."

THE NATURE OF CONFESSION

- Sin against God? <u>SECRET</u> confession.
- Sin against a person? <u>PRIVATE</u> confession.
- Sin against a group or community? **<u>PUBLIC</u>** confession.

The purpose of confession is to **<u>HEAL</u>** the relationship.

THE PRODIGAL SON'S MODEL:

- "I have sinned against heaven,
- "and against you.
- "I am no longer worthy to be called your son;
- "make me like one of your hired servants."

THE NATURE OF RECLAMATION

Who do we do this to? People who have <u>WANDERED</u> from the <u>TRUTH</u>.
Who does this reclamation? It's the job of <u>EVERY CHRISTIAN</u>.
How serious is this business? You could save a soul from <u>DEATH</u>.
What's the motivation for doing this? Jesus uses us as <u>INSTRUMENTS</u> in others lives to bring the love that "covers a multitude of sins."

James 5:16-20

¹⁶ Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

¹⁷ Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. ¹⁸ Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops.

¹⁹ My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, ²⁰ remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
