HEBREWS 1:4 – 2:4

- ⁴So he became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is superior to theirs.
- ⁵ For to which of the angels did God ever say,
- "You are my Son;

today I have become your Father"?

Or again,

"I will be his Father,

and he will be my Son"?

- ⁶ And again, when God brings his firstborn into the world, he says,
- "Let all God's angels worship him."
- ⁷ In speaking of the angels he says,
- "He makes his angels spirits,

and his servants flames of fire."

- ⁸ But about the Son he says,
- "Your throne, O God, will last for ever and ever;
 - a scepter of justice will be the scepter of your kingdom.
- ⁹ You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy."
- ¹⁰ He also says,
- "In the beginning, Lord, you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands.
- 11 They will perish, but you remain;

they will all wear out like a garment.

¹² You will roll them up like a robe; like a garment they will be changed.

But you remain the same,

and your years will never end."

- ¹³ To which of the angels did God ever say,
- "Sit at my right hand

until I make your enemies

a footstool for your feet"?

- ¹⁴ Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?
- **2** We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. ² For since the message spoken through angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, ³ how shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴ God also testified to it by signs, wonders and various miracles, and by gifts of the Holy Spirit distributed according to his will.
