HOW TO BECOME RIGHTEOUS

- Jesus teaches that true purity comes from a <u>HEART</u> that has been made <u>RIGHTEOUS</u> by God.
- External actions do not make a person clean before God, because God's judgment concerns behavior that <u>ORIGINATES</u> in the <u>HEART</u> of a person.
- Before you enter his kingdom by faith, Jesus will **OFFEND** you.

DISCIPLESHIP TO JESUS IN THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN

- The <u>SUPREMACY</u> of the <u>WORD</u> of God.
 a. Where tradition is FAULTY God's word is FLAWLESS.
- The <u>CENTRALITY</u> of the <u>HEART</u> in a person's life. (Jeremiah 17:9, Ezekiel 18:30-32)
 - a. Hearts harden from the **<u>INSIDE</u>** when we say <u>NO</u> to what God wants from us.
 - b. Hearts harden against the <u>OUTSIDE</u> when we try to protect ourselves from being <u>HURT</u>.
- The necessity of <u>FAITH</u> for <u>ALL</u> people.
 - a. Jesus' compassionate care is available to all who take his
 <u>WORD</u> and <u>WILL</u> as their
 <u>REALITY</u> and <u>PURPOSE</u> for life.

GETTING STARTED

1. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything that particularly caught your attention, challenged, inspired or confused you?

DIGGING DEEPER

2. Read Matthew 15:1-20

Jesus speaks critically to the Pharisees about their wrong-headed emphasis on external ritual purity, but they miss the heart, the right inner motivation.

They are overly concerned with handwashing and body purity as a sign of religious faithfulness. Can you think of an example of something in your own life you've been overly focused on, that wasn't the *heart* of the matter?

In verses 10-11, 18 Jesus says, Listen and understand. ¹¹ What goes into someone's mouth does not defile them, but what comes out of their mouth, that is what defiles them... ¹⁸ But the things that come out of a person's mouth come from the heart, and these defile them. Why is this such an important truth, then, and now?

3. Read Matthew 15:21-28 How would you describe the CHALLENGE Jesus gives to this woman, and then how would you characterize her RESPONSE?

Do you relate to either his challenge, or her response? Or are you

offended by it?

GETTING PERSONAL

4. Three big themes in this chapter that describe the Kingdom of Heaven, and discipleship to Jesus are:

- 1. The SUPREMACY of the WORD of God. (God's revealed authority in Jesus, and in the scriptures over human authority.)
- 2. The CENTRALITY of the HEART in a person's life. (Jesus' response to the Pharisees externally focused legalism.)
- 3. The necessity of FAITH for ALL people. (Jews and Gentiles alike need to place their confidence and trust in Jesus.)

Consider each point, and answer this question for each one: How and why is this such a crucial idea?

BRINGING IT HOME

5. The final point from the weekend message was: *Jesus'* compassionate care is available to all who take his word and will as their reality and purpose for life.

How do you need to live in and apply this truth for your life this week?
