² The words of Amos, one of the shepherds of Tekoa – the vision he saw concerning Israel two years before the earthquake, when... Jeroboam... was king of Israel. He said: "The Lord roars from Zion and thunders from Jerusalem."

⁶ This is what the Lord says: For three sins of Gaza, even for four, I will not relent. Because she took captive whole communities and sold them to Edom.

Amos 2

⁴ This is what the Lord says: For three sins of Judah, even for four, I will not relent. Because they have rejected the law of the Lord and have not kept his decrees, because they have been led astray by false gods...

⁶ For this is what the Lord says: For three sins of Israel, even for four, I will not relent. They sell the innocent for silver, and the needy for a pair of sandals."

¹⁻² Hear this word, people of Israel, the word of the Lord has spoken against you – against the whole family I brought up out of Egypt: You only have I chosen of all the families of the earth; therefore I will punish you for all your sins."

Amos 4

¹ Hear this word, you cows of Bashan on Mount Samaria, you women who oppress the poor and crush the needy and say to your husbands, "Bring us some drinks!"

⁶ I gave you empty stomachs in every city and lack of bread in every town, yet you have not returned to me.
