

New Life in Jesus Christ

Romans 6:1-14

Baptism captures the Truth of the death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ. When someone repents and professes faith in Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins, that person is baptized. Baptism shows they are following Jesus into death from sin and are resurrected to new life.

1. Dead to sin (v. 1-3)

Believers no longer live in and for sin. Baptisms' meaning of death and burial shows we are putting sin behind us (Repentance=turn away from sin)

Colossians 2:11-15; Galatians 3:26-29; Galatians 2:20

2. Newness of Life (v.4-11)

Living in and for Jesus Christ is both the power and purpose of the resurrection. Christians' new life does not begin when Jesus returns but begins from faith.

Ephesians 1:16-21; Philippians 2:12-13;

Matthew 22:35-40

3. Instruments of Righteousness (v.12-14)

Living in and for Jesus Christ means that we walk with Him daily to be used for God's Purpose and Will.

Romans 12:1-2; 2 Timothy 2:20-26; 2 Peter 3:8-15
