“¹⁰ For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago.”

The word “workmanship” comes from the Greek word “poiema”, from which we get our English word poem and means a manufactured product or masterpiece.

#1. The fruits of salvation are produced by God (Philippians 2:12-13.)
