

**A Great Awakening
2 Chronicles 7:12-14**

“¹² Then the Lord appeared to Solomon by night, and said to him: “I have heard your prayer, and have chosen this place for Myself as a house of sacrifice. ¹³ When I shut up heaven and there is no rain, or command the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people, ¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.”

#1. A nation who belongs to Him (V.14a.)

“¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name.”

#2. God’s people humble themselves before the Lord (V14b.)

“¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves,”

- Luke 14:11; James 4:10

Is our nation humble and submitted before God?

#3. Gods People seek Gods face (V.14c)

“¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face,”

- Jeremiah 29:11-13; John 10:27; John 14:15

Is our nation seeking God’s face?

#4. Gods people repent and turn from their wicked sinful way (V.14d)

“¹⁴ if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways,”

- Mark 1:14-15; Luke 5:32; Acts 3:19; 2 Peter 3:9
