**Let God Control the Way
(Proverbs 3:5)**

“⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart.”

The word heart “*leb*” in the Hebrew means the inner self that thinks, feels, and decides (the will.)

#1. Why does the heart need to be under God's control?

- Proverbs 4:23; Genesis 6:5; Jeremiah 17:9-10; Mark 7:20-23

#2. The promise of a new heart under God's control.

- Deuteronomy 30:15-19; Ezekiel 36:26-27; Jeremiah 24:7; Psalm 51:10; Colossians 3:10

Do you have a new heart under God's control?

#3. Let God control the way.

- Proverbs 3:5

The word trust “*betah*” means to have an intimate belief and trust in God's love and purpose for your life.

- 1st-The new heart is the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit taking up residence in your heart.
 - Revelation 3:19-20; Psalm 119:10; 1 Corinthians 3:16

Have you surrendered your heart to Jesus and invited him into your heart?

- 2nd-The person's aim in life will change.
 - Proverbs 16:9
