Debris Removal

- Hurricane debris must be placed at the curb in three separate piles: Vegetative debris, construction debris, and appliances.
- Residents may drop off vegetative debris at 2930 NW 13th Street from 8 a.m. - 6 p.m. daily; You Must bring your ID to show you are a Cape Coral resident. Do not place debris in bags.
