WE AGREE.

We agree on the PURPOSE of Marriage.

Genesis 1

²⁶ Then God said, "Let us make mankind in our image, to be like us. They will rule and reign over . . . (creation)."

Genesis 2

⁷ Then the Lord God formed the man from the dust of the ground. He breathed the breath of life into the man's nostrils, and the man became a living person. ¹⁵ The Lord God placed the man in the Garden of Eden to work it and to keep it. ¹⁸ Then the Lord God said,

"It is not good for the man to be alone.

I will make a helper who is just right for him."

- ²¹ So the Lord God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep. While the man slept, the Lord God took out one of the man's ribs and closed up the opening. ²² Then the Lord God made a woman from the rib, and he brought her to the man. ²³ "At last!" the man exclaimed. "This one is bone from my bone, and flesh from my flesh! She will be called 'woman,' because she was taken from man."
 - ²⁴ This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into ONE.
- ²⁵ Now the man and his wife were both naked, and were not ashamed. ^{1:28} Then God blessed them and said,

"Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth, rule it and reign over it." 1:31 Then God looked over all he had made and he saw that it was very good.

GOD created marriage to make life BETTER.

We agree on the ORDER of Marriage.

1 Corinthians 11

³ The head of every man is Christ, the head of woman is man, and the head of Christ is God.

Head: the source of - the headwaters

¹¹ But among the Lord's people, women are not independent of men, and men are not independent of women. ¹² For although the first woman came from man, every other man was born from a woman, and everything comes from God.

GOD > HE > SHE > WE

Ephesians 5

- ²¹ Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
- ²² For **wives**, this means submit to your husbands as to the Lord. ²³ For a husband is the head of his wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of his body, the church. ²⁴ As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything.

Submit: to yield to, to get behind leader (military term)

- ²⁵ For **husbands**, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. ²⁶ He gave up his life for her to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God's word.
- ²⁸ In the same way, **Husbands** ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies. For a man who loves his wife actually shows love for himself. ²⁹ No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church. ³¹ As the Scriptures say . . .

"A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into ONE."

³² This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and church are one.

We agree on the GIFT of Marriage.

1 Corinthians 7

⁷ God gives to some the gift of marriage, and to others the gift of singleness.

Ecclesiastes 4

⁹ Two are better off than one, for they can help each other succeed. ¹⁰ If one person falls, the other can reach out and help. But someone who falls alone is in real trouble. ¹¹ Likewise, two people lying close together can keep each other warm. But how can one be warm alone? ¹² A person standing alone can be attacked and defeated, but two can stand back-to-back and conquer.

If you treat your spouse like a GIFT maybe they'll be more GIVING.

We agree on the COVENANT of Marriage.

We Share what we're **FEELING**.

Romans 12

¹⁵ Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

Psalm 34

The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles.
 The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed.

God doesn't <u>AVOID</u> feelings He moves <u>CLOSE</u> to them.

Proverbs 4

²³ Guard your heart above all else, for it determines the course of your life.

Feelings are the <u>TEMPERATURE</u> of the Heart.

James 1

¹⁹ Be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry.

The TRUTH about Feelings.

- Feelings take a lot of time to uncover.
- Feelings take a lot of time to <u>recover</u>.
- Feelings may not be <u>right</u> but they're <u>real</u>.
- Feelings may require some <u>outside help</u>.

Take Action:

- Ask for <u>help</u>. (personal mentor, professional counselor)
- Ask <u>emotional</u> and <u>factual</u> questions.
- Listen to their words and their body language.
- Schedule intentional time together.

We Share what we're **LEARNING**.

Deuteronomy 6

⁶ Commit yourselves wholeheartedly to these commands that I am giving you today. ⁷ Repeat them again and again to your children. Talk about them when you are at home and when you are on the road, when you are going to bed and when you are getting up. ⁸ Tie them to your hands and wear them on your forehead as reminders. ⁹ Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

We work for GOD's glory.


Colossians 3

10 Things We Enjoy.

1. Everyday Life.

Ecclesiastes 11:9 - It's wonderful to be young! Enjoy every minute of it. Do everything you want to do; take it all in. But remember that you must give an account to God for everything you do.

2. A Good Meal.

Ecclesiastes 3:13 - People should eat and drink and enjoy the fruits of their labor, for these are gifts from God.

3. A Good Laugh.

Psalm 126:2-3 - We were filled with laughter and we sang with joy. Yes, the Lord has done amazing things for us! What joy!

Proverbs 17:22 - A cheerful heart is good medicine.

4. What We Have.

Ecclesiastes 6:9 - Enjoy what you have rather than desiring what you don't have. Just daydreaming about nice things is meaningless - like chasing the wind.

5. Love, Intimacy, and Sex.

Genesis 2:25 - Now the man and his wife were both naked, but they felt no shame.

Proverbs 5:15-19 - Drink water from your own well - share your love only with your wife. Why spill the water of your springs in the streets, having sex with

just anyone? You should reserve it for yourselves. Never share it with strangers.

Let your wife be the fountain of blessing for you.

Rejoice in the wife of your youth. She is a loving deer,
a graceful doe. Let her breasts satisfy you always.

May you always be captivated by her love.

1 Corinthians 7:3-5 - The husband should fulfill his wife's sexual needs; and the wife should fulfill her husband's needs. The wife gives authority over her body to her husband, and the husband gives authority over his body to his wife. Do not deprive each other of sexual relations.

6. Time Together.

Psalm 128:1-6 - How joyful are those who fear the Lord - all who follow his ways! You will enjoy the fruit of your labor. How joyful and prosperous you will be! Your wife will be like a fruitful grapevine, flourishing within your home. Your children will be like vigorous young olive trees as they sit around your table.

That is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him. May you live to enjoy your grandchildren.

7. Time Alone.

Genesis 2:2 - On the seventh day God had finished his work of creation, so he rested from all his work.

Exodus 34:21 - You have six days each week for your ordinary work; but on the seventh day you must stop working, even during the seasons of plowing and harvest.

Luke 5:16 - But Jesus often withdrew to the wilderness for prayer.

8. Time With Friends.

Romans 12:13 - Always be eager to practice hospitality.

Acts 2:46 - They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity - all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people.

Proverbs 11:25 - The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.

9. The Season We're In.

Ecclesiastes 3:1,11 - For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. God makes everything beautiful in his time.

10. The Season That's Coming.

Galatians 6:8-9 - Those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. So let's not get tired of doing what is good. For in due season, you'll reap a harvest if you don't give up.

Isaiah 3:10 - Tell the godly that all will be well for them. They will enjoy the rich reward they have earned!
