The Truth about Leadership.

- Leaders don't always have titles.
- Leaders don't always have authority.
- Leaders don't always have <u>popularity</u>.

Jesus was the greatest leader in history.

- He lead a group of volunteers for 3 years.
- He wasn't wealthy or famous
- He never traveled outside of his country.
- But He <u>changed the world</u> with his Life!

The only difference between a <u>good</u> leader and a <u>bad</u> leader is how they use their <u>influence</u>.

Jesus in the Temple.

Luke 2

- ⁴¹ Every year Jesus' parents went to Jerusalem for the Passover festival. ⁴² When Jesus was twelve years old, they attended the festival as usual. ⁴³ After the celebration was over, they started home to Nazareth, but Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem. His parents didn't miss him at first, ⁴⁴ because they assumed he was among the other travelers. But when he didn't show up that evening, they started looking for him among their relatives and friends.
- ⁴⁵ When they couldn't find him, they went back to Jerusalem to search for him there. ⁴⁶ Three days later they finally discovered him in the Temple, sitting among the religious teachers, listening to them and asking questions.
- ⁴⁷ All who heard him were amazed at his understanding and his answers.
- ⁴⁸ His parents didn't know what to think. "Son," his mother said to him, "why have you done this to us? Your father and I have been frantic, searching for you everywhere."
- ⁴⁹ "But why did you need to search?" he asked. "Didn't you know that I must be in my Father's house?" ⁵⁰ But they didn't understand what he meant. ⁵¹ Then he returned to Nazareth with them and was obedient to them. And his mother stored all these things in her heart.
- ⁵² Jesus grew in <u>wisdom</u> and in <u>stature</u> and in <u>favor</u> with God and man.
