The Challenges.

- You're too <u>busy</u> or too <u>tired</u>.
- Your <u>spouse</u> isn't helping out.
- You think it's too late.
- You've been <u>hurt</u>.
- You don't know how.

7 ways to Lead your Family.

1. Lead Yourself First.

Mark 12

³⁰ You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.
³¹ The second (commandment) is equally important: Love your neighbor as yourself.

- You can't give what you don't have.
- God > You > Family > Others

"Leaders that last - lead themselves first." - Andy Stanley

2. Know Where You're Going.

Psalm 78

⁴ We will not hide these truths from our children; we will tell the next generation about the glorious deeds of the Lord, about his power and his mighty wonders. ⁶ So the next generation might know them - even the children not yet born - and they in turn will teach their own children. ⁷ So each generation should set its hope anew on God, not forgetting his glorious miracles and obeying his commands.

- #1 job as a parent is to point your children to God.
- When you start with the <u>end</u> in mind you'll know what to do in the <u>middle</u>.

3. Work as a <u>Team</u>.

Genesis 2

¹⁸ Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for man to be alone. I will make a <u>helper</u> who is just right for him." ²⁴ This explains why a man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into ONE.

Colossians 3

¹⁸ Wives submit to your husbands, as is fitting for those who belong to the Lord. ¹⁹ Husbands, love your wives and never treat them harshly.

Ephesians 5

²¹ Submit to ONE ANOTHER out of reverence for Christ.

Galatians 3

²⁶ For you are all children of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
²⁸ There is no longer Jew or Gentile, slave or free, male and female. For you are all ONE in Christ.

- Marriage is a covenant to be <u>friends</u>, <u>partners</u> and <u>lovers</u> for life.
- It doesn't matter <u>who</u> does what what matters is that <u>we</u> get it all done.

4. Do the Next <u>Right</u> Thing.

Proverbs 4

²⁵⁻²⁷ Look straight ahead, and fix your eyes on what lies before you. Mark out a straight path for your feet; stay on the safe path. Don't get sidetracked; keep your feet from following evil

- Come up with a plan.
- Work your <u>plan</u>.

5. Ask for <u>Help</u>.

James 1

⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

- The <u>Holy Spirit</u> is your helper.
- Your <u>spouse</u> is your helper.
- Your <u>community</u> is your helper.

6. Lead with Joy.

Isaiah 55

 $^{\rm 12}$ You shall go out in joy and be led forth in peace.

- When you focus on things that are <u>Joyful</u> you'll have more <u>Joy</u>.
- Children are God's <u>blessing</u> that we get to <u>manage</u>.

7. Put Your <u>Hope</u> in the Lord.

Psalm 71

⁵ O Lord, you alone are my hope.I've trusted you, O Lord, from childhood.

- The Lord is the <u>only</u> one who won't let you down.
- Hope is believing that <u>God</u> can do what <u>you</u> can't.
