Leadership is <u>INFLUENCE</u> and <u>EVERYBODY</u> has influence.

Q: What's your # 1 Job as a Leader? *Protect, Provide, Direct, Manage, etc...*

TRUTH: Your # 1 Job as a Leader is to Guard Your Heart.

Proverbs 4:23

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

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Luke 12 - Parable of the Rich Fool

¹³ Then someone called from the crowd, "Teacher, please tell my brother to divide our father's estate with me."
¹⁴ Jesus replied, "Friend, who made me a judge over you to decide such things as that?" ¹⁵ Then he said,

"Beware! Guard against every kind of greed. Life is not measured by how much you own."

Beware = "to stare at, to pay attention, to be aware of."
Guard = "to protect from, to avoid, to stay away from."

3 Enemies of the Heart:

- Pride: "It's all because of me."
- Worry: "It's all up to me."
- Greed: "It's all for me."

1. Fight Pride with Gratefulness.

Luke 12

¹⁶ Then he told them a story: "A rich man had a fertile farm that produced fine crops. ¹⁷ He said to himself, 'What should I do? I don't have room for all my crops.' ¹⁸ Then he said, 'I know! I'll tear down my barns and build bigger ones. Then I'll have room enough to store all my wheat and other goods. ¹⁹ And I'll sit back and say to myself, "My friend, you have enough stored away for years to come. Now take it easy! Eat, drink, and be merry!"' ²⁰⁻²¹ "But God said to him,

'You fool! You will die this very night. Then who will get everything you worked for?' "Yes, a person is a fool to store up earthly wealth but not have a <u>rich relationship with God</u>."

The Truth about Pride.

- Pride says, "It's all <u>because</u> of me."
- Pride gives you a <u>false</u> sense of reality.
- You can't be prideful and grateful at the same time.

GRATEFULNESS is giving <u>God</u>

the glory and <u>others</u> the credit.

2. Fight Worry with Faithfulness.

Luke 12

²² Then, turning to his disciples, Jesus said, "That is why I tell you <u>not to worry about everyday life</u> - whether you have enough food to eat or enough clothes to wear. ²³ For life is more than food, and your body more than clothing. ²⁴ Look at the ravens. They don't plant or harvest or store food in barns, for God feeds them. And you are far more valuable to him than any birds! ²⁵ Can all your worries add a single moment to your life? ²⁶ And if worry can't accomplish a little thing like that, what's the use of worrying over bigger things? ²⁷ "Look at the lilies and how they grow. They don't work or make their clothing, yet Solomon in all his glory was not dressed as beautifully as they are. ²⁸ And if God cares so wonderfully for flowers that are here today and thrown into the fire tomorrow, he will certainly care for you. <u>Why do you</u> <u>have so little faith</u>? ²⁹ "And don't be concerned about what to eat and what to drink. Don't worry about such things. ³⁰ These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers all over the world, but your Father already knows your needs.

³¹ Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and he will give you everything you need.

The Truth about Worry.

- Worry says, "It's all up to me."
- Worry <u>assumes</u> that God is absent.
- Worry <u>consumes</u> you and <u>distracts</u> you.

FAITHFULNESS is doing what you <u>can</u> and trusting God with what you <u>can't</u>.

3. Fight Greed with Generosity.

Luke 12

³² "So don't be afraid, little flock. For it gives your Father great happiness to give you the Kingdom. ³³ "Sell your possessions and <u>give to those in need</u>. This will store up treasure for you in heaven! And the purses of heaven never get old or develop holes. Your treasure will be safe; no thief can steal it and no moth can destroy it. ³⁴ Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be.

The Truth about Greed.

- Greed says, "It's all for me."
- Greed makes you <u>blind</u> to those around you.
- The only way to defeat greed is with generosity.

GENEROSITY is trading what you can't <u>keep</u> for something you can't <u>lose</u>.
