The Truth about Control.

- We carry things we were <u>never</u> meant to carry.
- We <u>hurt</u> the people around us.
- We lose our joy.

3 Ways to Surrender.

1. Trust God.

Proverbs 3:5-6

- Trust God with the small stuff.
- Trust God with the <u>big</u> stuff.

2. Obey God.

Proverbs 3:7-8

⁷ Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil. ⁸ Then you will have healing for your body and strength for your bones.

- Obey God when you don't understand.
- Obey God when you don't <u>agree</u>.

3. Honor God.

Proverbs 3:9-10

⁹ Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. ¹⁰ Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with Good wine.

- Honor God with your <u>money</u>.
- Honor God with your <u>work</u>.
- Honor God with your <u>blessings</u>.
