WELCOME

Pastor Dale returns this week and continues his series "Made on Purpose."

For the ice breaker this week, share your answers to the following question: What did you want to be when you grew up when were a kid?

WORSHIP

Start the worship time by encouraging people to share praises for what God has done in their life this past week. Sing worship songs from the Sunday services or select your own.

WORD

- I. Spiritual Objective. At the end of the discussion, members will:
 - **A.** Discuss how we can live our lives in a way that Glorifies God.
 - **B.** Talk about the people we influence and whether we are influencing people to or away from God.

II. The Sermon Synopsis:

God has made each of us on purpose and with a purpose. God is working in each of us and shaping each of us for His purposes. One of those purposes is to change and impact the world. God saves us for more than just going to Heaven. He has a purpose for us and has created us with specific talents, skills, and personalities to influence others around us.

Every day we influence others around us whether we know it or not. As Christians we also influence others either towards God or away from God. When we act out of godly character we glorify God through our actions. As we step forward boldly in faith, and as God works in our lives, our lives impact the World. Small acts of faith are multiplied by God and have an impact beyond what we can often see.

The Text:

¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! ¹⁸ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: ¹⁹ that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. ²⁰ We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.

(2 Corinthians 5:17-20 NIV)

Discussion Questions

- III. Christians are called to impact the world by the way we live. God has created each of us with a specific set of gifts that can impact others. How does your life glorify God? Would others see God's love in how you behave? Why or why not?
- **IV.** Ephesians 2:8-10 talks about the fact that we were created in Jesus to do good works. We influence others with the way we live. *If your life reflects what God has done and what God can do for others, what areas of your life would you like to improve?*
- **V.** God wants us to influence people for the rest of our lives. Every day we can influence people either towards or away from God by how we act. Who are the people in your life that you influence? Your family? Your co-workers? Friends? What can you do to be intentional with them?
- **VI.** Pastor Dale shared two stories, one about his grandfather who started Hope Mission, who serves the poor and marginalized, and his father, who came and pastored Kapahulu Bible church. The way these two men lived and influenced others had a generational effect that still impacts how Pastor Dale and his sons live. *Is the way you are living impacting and inspiring others to live in a similar way? Why or why not?*



VII. The second story Pastor Dale shared was of David, a C&MA surgeon whose parents died as missionaries to Vietnam. David spent his life working in a hospital in Gabon, and at the age of 65, asked to reassigned to a hospital in North African. David is an example of how God can use any of us to impact the world if we serve Him in our strengths. What are your strengths, talents, and skills? How are you using them for God? If you are not, what is preventing you from doing so?

WORK
