

Let The Nations Be Glad – Psalm 67 November 10, 2019

Read and Examine – As you read the passage together consider these questions:

- Read Psalm 67.
- In your own words what is the main point of the passage?

Apply – Consider how God intends this passage to shape your life.

- Can you trace God's desire for the nations throughout the storyline of the Bible? What texts would you go to? Work with your CG to hit some important texts from Genesis to Revelation to develop an understanding of God's plan to rescue for himself a people from every, tribe, tongue, and nation.
- What is the relationship between the Psalmist's prayer for blessing and the worship of God among all peoples?
- What is it that God has given you (time, gifts, money, etc) that you might better use for the sake of his name among the nations?
- What is the danger in making the blessings of God the goal and our treasure instead of him? How do we guard against this especially in the affluent area in which we live?
- What are some obstacles that you face internally when you think of how God intends to use you for his fame among all nations? What are some obstacles a church might face as they set to leverage what God has given them for the joy of the nations?
- What is something that really stood out to you in this passage/sermon?

Pray – You've been hearing from God in his word now respond to him in prayer

- Ask God to use you in this coming year for the spread of his fame among all peoples.
