"the Christ" = Jesus is the Messiah, the anointed Savior, and the fulfillment of all of the Old Testament prophecies.

"the Son of God" = Jesus is God.

"believe" = It's more than just believing facts. It's personal faith. "Believe" is a verb here, not a noun.

- Zechariah 9:9 (520 B.C.) Messiah will enter Jerusalem riding on a donkey.
- Matthew 21:1-10 Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey.
