



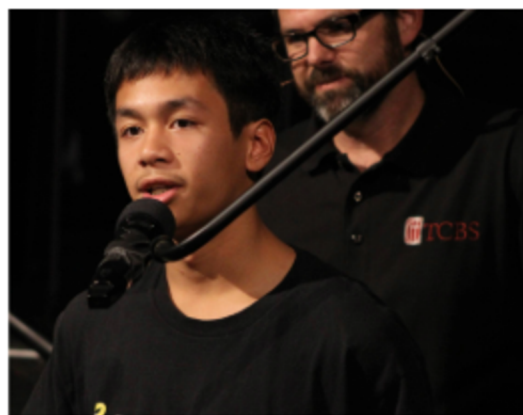

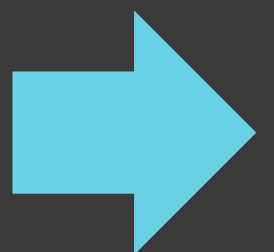

3 For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: **that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,** 4 **and that He was buried, and that He was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,** 5 and that He appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. 6 After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep; 7 then He appeared to James, then to all the apostles; 8 and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.





HISTORICAL FACT: JESUS DIED BY CRUCIFIXION

Christian and secular historians are unanimous that Jesus of Nazareth died by crucifixion.

EARLY EYEWITNESS TESTIMONY

>500 witnesses testified to seeing who they claimed was Jesus of Nazareth days after his death.

3 IMMEDIATE EXPANSION OF CHRISTIANITY

The resurrection of Jesus was believed immediately after the crucifixion, leading to an sudden, explosive revolution.

SKEPTICS SUDDENLY TRANSFORMED

Christianity's greatest opponent
became its greatest proponent.

RADICAL CHANGE IN JESUS' FAMILY

James and Jude, the unbelieving half-brothers of Jesus became believers and church martyrs after the alleged resurrection event.

INADEQUACY OF NATURALISTIC EXPLANATIONS

Alternative explanations are regularly proposed, but they fail to adequately account for the evidence.

SUFFERING & MARTYRDOM OF DISCIPLES

Thousands willingly were martyred for a story that gave them no wordly benefit.

EMBARRASSING WITNESS DETAILS

Resurrection details work against its cause.
Historians call this “the criterion of embarrassment.”

HE IS RISEN.

1 Corinthians 15:16-22

“...if the dead are not raised, not even Christ has been raised. **And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins.** Then those also who have fallen asleep in Christ have perished. *If in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied.*

But IN FACT, Christ HAS been raised from the dead, the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. For as by a man came death, by a Man has come also the resurrection of the dead. For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.”

Acts 17:30-31

30 Therefore having overlooked the times of ignorance, God is now declaring to men that all people everywhere should **repent**,

31 because **He has fixed a day in which He will judge the world in righteousness through a Man whom He has appointed**, having furnished proof to all men **by raising Him from the dead."**
