

HOW TO DISCIPLE: A WORKABLE MODEL

INTRODUCTION

A. An Invitation

1. Pray for those you might disciple (Luke 6:12-13).

2. Have an initial meeting
 - (1) Review the curriculum

 - (2) Relationship

 - (3) Requirements
 1. Do the assigned lesson.

 2. Be available: time commitment.

 3. Be teachable.

 4. Set a time and place where you will meet.

 5. Set a deadline.

- (4) Challenge him to continue the discipleship chain (2 Tim 2:2).

Help your disciple understand the exponential effect discipleship has:

- (5) Ask him to pray.

B. The Disciple's Commitment:

In order to grow toward maturity in Christ and complete the discipleship process, I commit myself to the following standards:

1. Complete all assignments on a weekly basis prior to my discipleship appointment in order to contribute fully. [It will take about two hours per week to complete the discipleship material plus a variable amount of time to memorize the Scripture.]
2. Meet weekly with my discipleship partners for approximately 90 minutes to dialogue over the content of the assignments with the goal of practical application.
3. Offer myself fully to the Lord with the anticipation that He will use this discipleship period to mature me further.
4. Contribute to a climate of honesty, trust, and openness in a spirit of mutual equipping.
5. Give serious consideration to continue the discipleship chain by committing myself to invest in at least two other people following my completion of this discipleship process.
