Qualifications of a Discippler

1. You agree with the Doctrinal Statement of CBC.
2. You are a member of CBC.
3. You faithfully attend worship services: Sunday school, morning and evening worship services, and a small group (HFG, COV, CORE).
4. You show basic understanding of biblical and theological truth by completing a doctrinal questionnaire.
5. You commit to carry out the “Disciple’s Commitment” as a leader.
6. You are an example to others by manifesting a stable, consistent Christian life.
7. You demonstrate a teachable and submissive spirit.
8. You have been discipled.
