1. The importance of being a godly example!

When it comes to discipleship, people are not simply looking for an explanation but an example.

Charles Spurgeon said, “A man’s life is always more forcible than his speech. When men take stock of him they reckon his deeds as dollars and his words as pennies. If his life and doctrine disagree, the mass of onlookers accept his practice and reject his preaching.”¹

2. The qualifications of a discipler.

- 1) You agree with the Doctrinal Position of CBC.
- 2) You are a member of CBC.
- 3) You faithfully attend the worship services: Sunday school, morning and evening worship services, and a small group (e.g. HFG, COV, CORE).
- 4) You show basic understanding of biblical and theological truth by completing a doctrinal questionnaire.
- 5) You commit to carry out the “Disciple’s Commitment” as a leader.
- 6) You are an example to others by manifesting a stable, consistent Christian life.
- 7) You demonstrate a teachable and submissive spirit.
- 8) You have been disciplined.
