Introduction:

- 1. You have been chosen for salvation (1:1-2)
 - -According to the foreknowledge of God the Father
 - -By the sanctifying work of the Spirit
 - -To obey Jesus Christ and be sprinkled with His blood
- 2. You can rejoice over your salvation and its benefits in spite of current trials (1:3-9)
 - -You can rejoice knowing that God has mercifully caused you to be born again
 - *to a living hope
 - *to obtain an inheritance
 - *protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time
 - -You can rejoice knowing that you are obtaining the precious proof of your faith
- 3. You should remember that your salvation was first prophesied and then preached to you (1:10-12)
- 4. You have been changed in your relationship toward God as a result of your salvation (1:13-21)
 - You are to have a fixed hope
 - *Prepare your minds for action
 - *Keep sober in spirit
 - You are to be holy in all your behavior
 - You are to conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay on earth
