## Ecclesiastes #15 (11/2) 'Wisdom Makes Life Better' - Ecclesiastes7:1-14

For in much wisdom is much vexation, and he who increases knowledge increases sorrow. – Ecclesiastes 1:18 (ESV)

For who knows what is good for man while he lives the few days of his vain life, which he passes like a shadow? For who can tell man what will be after him under the sun? - Ecclesiastes 6:12 (ESV)

## Wisdom makes Life **<u>BETTER</u>**. But how?

1. Sorrow is better than I ? (v.1–3)

And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing" - James 1:2-4 (ESV) Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted - Matthew 5:4 (ESV) Woe to you who laugh now, for you shall mourn and weep - Luke 6:25 (ESV). <u>Godly grief</u> produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret - 2 Corinthians 7:10 (ESV)

Teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom - Psalm 90:12 (ESV)

A glad heart makes a cheerful face, but by sorrow of heart the spirit is crushed....15 All the days of the afflicted are evil, but the cheerful of heart has a continual feast. - Proverbs 15:13 & 15 (ESV)

**2. Wisdom brings** <u>b</u>\_\_\_\_\_(v.4-5)

Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, but he who hates reproof is stupid. - Proverbs 12:1 (ESV)

**3. Wisdom brings** <u>p</u> (v.6-10)

We know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. - Romans 8:28 (ESV)

As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good. - Genesis 50:20 (ESV)

4. Wisdom brings <u>b</u> (v.11–12)

5. Wisdom brings c\_\_\_\_\_ (v.13-14)

## Q. How is God portrayed?

- 2. God is <u>INVOLVED</u> (v.14)
- **3.** God can be <u>SECRETIVE</u> (v.14)
