

As you may know, Governor Gavin Newsome has banned all mass gatherings of 250 people in an effort to stem the flow of COVID-19.

While we plan to have our 3 worship services this Sunday (8AM+10AM+6PM), we will comply with the Governor request. We will limit attendance in our main sanctuary to 250. However, we will also set up two additional viewing rooms of 250 in our corporate offices at 1141 and 1143 East Janis to accomodate those who wish to worship but cannot access the main sanctuary. We will also live-stream each of our services, so those of you who choose not to attend can still worship with us.

We will also not ask anyone to shake hands, high-five, or hug your neighbor. Instead, we will simply say hello (or do an elbow bump!). We also ask that if you have symptoms of coughing, sneezing, fever, nausea, achiness, or any flu-like symptoms, we would prayerfully ask that you stay home and go to the doctor if needed. We will also NOT have Little Soliders, or any of our other Sunday classes. We will aggressively monitor the situation as it develops, and will take whatever measures necessary at the appropriate time.

We remain in prayer for the nations of the world, the responders on the front lines of this pandemic, and those individuals and their families who have been affected. We remain confident that even now God is with us, and has the whole world in his hands.
