## **KEY THOUGHTS**

- Many of us are familiar with the bell curve showing the arc of influence: Innovators, Early Adopters, Early Majority, Late Majority, and Laggards. This is a fairly accurate description of how influence spreads. There's a little bit of a battle, and then influence seems to explode. We love viral!
- Viral growth in the church often has problems. God's way of influence is better.
- 2 Timothy 1 chronicles Paul's relationship with Timothy, clothed in words of suffering, hardship, and battle language. This week we look at being an influencer when it is a battle.
- 2 Timothy 2:2 And the things which you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, these entrust to faithful men, who will be able to teach others also.
  - This is a SLOW path a glacier's pace!
- As we look at the steps, WHERE ARE YOU?
  - 1. Be discipled the things you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses
  - 2. Make a disciple these entrust to faithful men
  - 3. Help your disciple make another who will be able to teach others also. Like a glacier, the power of multiplication is slow... but oh so powerful!
