KEY THOUGHTS

- We need the Holy Spirit's help (The Paraclete The one who comes alongside us.)
- The Spirit of God prepares the way for the movement of God.
- The Spirit came upon specific individuals in certain places at certain times.
- The Spirit moved in times and places in the Old Testament, in some powerful ways, but few and far between.
- There's this promise of One who would come and would be different with Him in Isaiah 11:1-2.
- But there was another promise, directed not just to the promised ONE, but to the PEOPLE! WHAT IF the Spirit were unleashed in ALL of God's people, and He never left? WHAT IF! (Joel 2:28-29)
- The universal presence of the Holy Spirit to all God's people would be world-changing someday.
- Jesus ushered in the overflowing work of the Holy Spirit.
- It is the Holy Spirit that shows us our need for Christ
