

KEY THOUGHTS

- Revelation 12:1-11 describes a deep, cosmic battle in which we still are raging. While it is descriptive and full of imagery, don't lose sight of the fact that it's real and eternally significant.
 - In it we see Israel, Satan, angels, and of course the son, Jesus.
 - God has won, but the battle we face still rages see v.17.
- Verse 11 describes the overcoming (Greek word nike!), as well as our battle strategy
- Today, overcoming by the blood of the Lamb.
- But blood is a sign of loss, not victory. Also, we're told to be cleansed by the blood of Jesus. Nobody cleans WITH BLOOD! The blood of Jesus is different!
- The blood of Jesus inspires. But it has to be more than this.
- The blood of Jesus covers. This deals with the legal punishment of our sin.
- The blood of Jesus atones. This deals with the broken relationship between us and God. Hebrews 10:19
- The blood of Jesus
- The blood of Jesus cleans our conscience. This gives us peace and corrects our conscience. Hebrews 9:14
- The blood of Jesus corrects. The Biblical word in correcting our manner of living is sanctification. Hebrews 13:12
- The blood of Jesus heals. Isaiah 53:5
- His blood corrects EVERYTHING!
