Matt 20:24-25

And hearing this, the ten became indignant with the two brothers. But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great men exercise authority over them.

Matt 20:26-28

"It is not this way among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant, and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave; just as the Son of Man **did not come to be served, but to serve**, and to give His life a ransom for many."

John 13:1

Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

John 13:2

During supper, the devil having already put into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray Him,

John 13:3-4

Jesus, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come forth from God and was going back to God, got up from supper, and laid aside His garments; and taking a towel, He girded Himself.

John 13:5-6

Then He poured water into the basin, and began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. So He came to Simon Peter. He said to Him, "Lord, do You wash my feet?"

John 13:7-8

Jesus answered and said to him, "What I do you do not realize now, but you will understand hereafter." Peter said to Him, "Never shall You wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."

Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, then wash not only my feet, but also my hands and my head."
Jesus said to him, "He who has bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you."

1. We don't get the option of choosing when we are to serve.

Many allow their circumstances to keep
them from serving others

2. We don't get the option of who we are to serve

Not one of them were someone
I would **feel** like serving

I need to serve where and how I feel most comfortable.

I need to feel appreciated when I serve.

I need to see results from serving.

I feel I need to serve where I'm 'gifted'.

I don't feel comfortable serving certain kinds
of people.

I need to feel a passion for the thing or
area I serve in.
