## Acts 6:1

Now at this time while the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic Jews against the native Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving of food.

## Acts 10:28-29

And he said to them, "You yourselves know how unlawful it is for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him; and yet God has shown me that I should not call any man unholy or unclean.

Gen 12:3

And I will bless those who bless you,  
And the one who curses you I will curse.

And in you **all the families of the earth will be blessed.**"

# Prejudice

: preconceived **judgment** or **opinion**

: an adverse opinion or leaning formed without just grounds or **before** sufficient knowledge

**We are most tempted to sin when we are  
sinned against**

There is no one you will see today or any other  
today that Jesus didn't die for!



We **move toward people** (made in the image of God) for the purpose of showing/introducing them to Jesus or encouraging them in their walk with Jesus!

## Gal 6:10

So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the **household** of the faith.

## 2 Peter 3:8-9

The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, **not wishing for any to perish** but for all to come to repentance.
