

Adam Hatton Acts 3:1-12

DISCUSSION GUIDE:

- 1. This is the first miracle recorded in the book of Acts. Miracles in Acts represent God's hand on the apostles' ministry and symbolize the future restoration that God will one day bring. What part of our world are you excited to see God restore?
- 2. We see words throughout this passage that have to do with sight (seeing, look, attention). What does sight have to do with our spiritual life?
- 3. In verse 12, Peter makes it clear that this man was healed by God's power, not by the apostles' piety. What can we do to keep ourselves from taking credit for things that God is doing in our own lives?
- 4. Peter and John were on their way to pray but were attentive enough to give some time to the man who was asking for money. How can we be attentive to the "interruptions" in our own life and be ready to be used by God? Does anyone have a personal experience where an interruption turned out to be a story of God at work?
- 5. What can we do as a group to be attentive to the needs around us? Is there anything we can do together?
