## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### Colossians 1:16-17

*“The little phrase ‘all things were created for Him’ indicates that the Christ Who created life is also the goal toward which all of life and creation are moving.”*

1. Think about each of your roles (Christ-follower, spouse, parent, adult child, employee, leader, friend ...). List some of the things you do in those roles.
2. If Jesus created all things for Himself, then He created you for Himself (verse 16). In what ways does this comfort you or concern you?
3. For what purpose did He create you?
4. If Jesus is the Giver of life, what is the goal of life He gives? What can we do to be in the position of receiving the best from Him (verse 17)?
5. How should the fact that He is before all things and holds all things together affect our worldview (verse 17)?
6. How do you respond to the fact that all these things are under Jesus’ authority?

Does Christ come first in my life? Are my first thoughts of the day about Him? Do I pray to Him before I make decisions or take actions? Do I thank Him first when something good happens? Do I put following His will before following my own?
