DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Colossians 1:13-15, 19

“We will not know what to do with Jesus until we know who He is.”

1. Have you ever seen an optical illusion? How do distorted images manipulate our perspective? How does having a proper perspective of Jesus dictate our life, purpose and mission?
2. Read verses 13-14. How did Jesus’ divine nature qualify Him to provide redemption and the forgiveness of sins for God’s people? What of His human nature qualified Him for this accomplishment?
3. Have you neglected to recognize the equal importance of both the divinity and the humanity of Jesus? Why is it so important to hold these two natures together?
4. Read verses 15-20, what phrases clarify the true identity of Jesus? Which one of these traits communicate aspects of Jesus’ divinity? What about His humanity?
5. When Paul claimed that Jesus was the “firstborn of all creation,” what did he mean? How does this phrase help us more clearly understand who Jesus is?
6. Why should our convictions about Jesus always present themselves through a faith demonstrated and lived out daily? What is the relationship between thinking, believing and doing?
