DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Luke 22:14-21

- 1. Why do you think meals are so often a part of our celebrations in life? What's the most celebrated or memorable meal you have ever been a part of? What made it so special?
- 2. Why is the Lord's Supper an essential part of Christian practice today? What did participation in the Lord's Supper mean for you? What traditions or events do you observe to remind you of God's work in your life?
- 3. Jesus said He "earnestly desired" to share this Passover meal with His disciples. Do you think the moment was equally as meaningful for them? Why or why not? What was the significance of the bread? What was the significance of the cup?
- 4. In Jeremiah 31:31-34, how did Israel break the Old Covenant? What will the difference be between the Old and the New Covenant according to Jeremiah?
- 5. Why would the Lord say, "I will be their God, and they will be my people"? Was Israel not already His people? Have we yet seen the day when "they will all know Me, from the least to the greatest of them"?
- 6. What does it mean to take the body and blood of Christ with you as you leave the community of faith and go into the world each week?

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
