Ephesians 2:10 | John 4:34 | Matthew 7:21

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. (ESV)

"God doesn't always make His will clear because He values our being transformed more than our being informed." -Jon Bloom

1. How do you keep the world from squeezing you into its mold?
2. Discuss the process of transformation by renewing your mind as it relates to the head (mind), heart (emotions) and hands (actions).
3. How does testing lead to discerning the will of God?
4. God loves us and desires what is best for us; He is also omniscient and knows what is best for us. Since His will for our lives is "good and acceptable and perfect," it is in our own best interest to affirm His desires even when they are contrary to our own. What is Paul wanting his readers to understand about God's will being good, acceptable and perfect?
5. Pastor Cortis emphasized to let God remake us. What part does conviction and obedience play in this process?
6. What's your main takeaway from the last three Sundays on Romans 12:1-2?
