



## A Guide for Biblical Decision Making | Part 3

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

### DISCUSSION GUIDE:

1. In order to make God honoring decisions we should first assess what we are depending on for our help and hope. Discuss how we can assess this dependency. As believers, give examples of how we can focus our reliance on Christ.
2. One of the ways we can discern what is "God honoring" is through Scripture. What two things are we to be careful about when seeking God's will in His Word? Discuss how these two dangers can be avoided.
3. A second way we can discern God's will is through the Holy Spirit in us. Read Galatians 5:22-24, discuss how the fruit of the Spirit can help believers make godly decisions. Think of two or three life situations and what it would look like for the believer to be guided by the fruit of the Spirit.
4. Paul, in Romans 14:13-20, states we should not be a "stumbling block or hindrance" to another believer. What does he mean by this? Give some examples. How might this look different when we interact with those that don't know Christ? HINT: 1 Corinthians 9:19-23.
5. Though something is not a stumbling block for a fellow believer, nor will it prevent us from winning over a non-believer, it could potentially encourage sin in others. What is a good question to test this potentiality? Discuss life situations that illustrate this potential.
6. What was something new or challenging you learned from this teaching? What steps is God calling you to take from here?

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
