3. Do you find it easier to live out these things with fellow Christians or with those who don't know Christ? Why?
4. Which do you think is more difficult: to celebrate with other believers who are rejoicing or to weep with those who are hurting? Why?
5. What practical things can we do to weep with those in the church who weep and rejoice with those who rejoice?
6. What difference can “living with a bold love” make in a broken world?
