DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Romans 14:13-21

- We spent time last week studying what it means to "live and die to the Lord." (Rom. 14:7-12) We were reminded to <u>never forget</u> three things: who Jesus is, who we are in Jesus and what we are destined for with Jesus. In what ways did these truths impact your life this week? What about your relationships?
- If we are to be believers who truly follow Jesus and thus walk together in love, we are called to STOP doing three things stop getting in our brother's way (v. 13, 15b), stop getting in the Gospel's way (v.16-17) and stop getting in God's way (v. 20). Which of these three has the Holy Spirit convicted you of today? In what ways have you been getting in the way? Try and come up with examples for all three.
- 3. Spend some time discussing/thinking through how your life either detracts from or points to the Gospel of Christ. Consider how your life is a witness or a barrier to the saving work of Christ.
- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 10:23-33. What areas of your life have you treated as lawful AND beneficial? Why is this dangerous in regards to your neighbor?
- 5. What else spoke to you from today's message?
