DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Colossians 1:18, 24-29

"The point of the church is to be a people who, together, are a living, growing demonstration of the life and hope God gives in Jesus."

- 1. Who is the head of the church according to verse 18? Who is the church? What is the purpose of the church?
- 2. How did Paul view his sufferings in verse 24? Explain how one can have such an attitude regarding suffering.
- 3. What is this "mystery" that's been "hidden for ages and generations" according to verses 26, 27? In what sense is the gospel a mystery? What is our relationship to Christ according to verse 27?
- 4. Why do you think that suffering such as Paul endured as he wrote this letter from prison often serves to advance the gospel?
- 5. What priorities in our church reveal that we are proclaiming the gospel message to the world?
- 6. What was Paul's goal in preaching and teaching according to verses 28 & 29? What should Paul's goals in preaching teach us about our responsibility in sharing the gospel?

QUESTIONS TO PONDER THIS WEEK:

Am I making an ongoing sacrifice like Christ for others in the body? Am I in pursuit of a full knowledge of Christ? Do I have a deep confidence in Christ? Am I committed to learn Christ and be like Him in all of life? Do I show a readiness to labor for Christ in the things that matter to Him? Do I live with a persistent dependence on Christ?
